In May 2012 we worked with the Queen Mother's Foundation to give 68 sets of legs to landmine victims. Pictures above show the difference in Sha's life. Sha lost her leg when she was 8. Now she is 19 and works in a Wa clinic inside Burma. In November 2014, we plan to give 100 more sets of legs. In November 2013, Pastor John from our Wa Hostel and Church went back into Sha's area and baptized 90 more Wa. This makes 440 in the past four years. The Wa say, "We see the Christians have a much better life and we want that too."

- 7 – On the way out, we had to use two shaky bamboo logs to get across the flooded stream after the bridge washed out.

1 - Thai dancers, actors and preachers held 21 weeks of evangelism in 21 schools June to Oct.
 2 - Pastor Amnat has preached in these schools for the past 16 years. They make him wear his children's "Uncle Turtle" suit that he started wearing when they were little. This year he gave the calls and a total of 4080 students walked forward to receive Christ.



3 - CCI invited Allan to give the invitation for the Nursing students at Payap University and 73 walked forward to receive Christ. The 73 plus many others came for follow-up training. Now CCI is preparing their folk dramas "Likays" for rural evangelism in the dry season. We are leading them to the Talako to perform in 4 villages from Jan. 4-11 2014.
