CCI Folk Drama (Likay) Tour, January 2017

During the month of January the CCI (Christian Communications Institute) Folk Drama Troupe toured the border province of Tak performing in Thai and Karen villages, churches, and schools. They shared the gospel message with dance, songs and humor. The Director of Evangelism of the Church of Christ in Thailand preached and gave invitations to receive Christ. Many came forward and the local churches follow up.



“Before the Sunset” portrays, in Thai traditional style, the tragedy of a man who refused to repent until it was too late.



During the tour the troupe visited local schools and performed a drama raising the ethical questions of right and wrong based on an actual Thai court case. The students were invited to debate with the actors about the fairness of the punishment.



Like last year, Sugar’s friend gave about 3000 dozen pairs of socks to give out to needy children and adults on both sides of the northern Thai border. While giving out the socks, the troupe taught the children to sing, “God loves me, So I love you too.”
