Follow-up on Cleft and Lip Palate Operations

Pan Rak Foundation sent Oratai and her daughter, Mint, to follow up on 23 cleft lip and palate patients in the southern Wa State, Myanmar in June. You can see the amazing difference in their lives from the pictures below (taken between 3-5 months after the operation).

At the end of July, we are bringing at least 30 more Wa patients to Kengtung, Myanmar. The Smile Train Foundation is arranging with the Myanmar government to bring doctors in for the operations. Our team is able to share the Gospel through our newly produced Wa Catechism while the patients and their parents wait for their operations.
